Introduction

Author's Note

There is a wide variety of e-book formats that can be divided into 2 categories: PDF/exe and e-publications (ePub, MOBI, etc.). This report discusses self publishing your ebook in a variety of e-publishing formats at Smashwords. It should be noted that the e-publishing format is ideally suited to fiction, as these formats don't display graphics very well at this stage.

Mark Coker founded Smashwords in 2008 to change the way books are published, marketed and sold.

Mark is co-author along with his wife, Lesleyann, of Boob Tube, a novel that explores the behind-the-scenes world of daytime television soap operas. It was Mark's experience trying to get Boob Tube published that inspired him to start Smashwords. He believes Smashwords holds the promise to make publishing more enriching for authors, readers and publishers.

In the three years since its launch, Smashwords has grown to become the leading ebook publishing and distribution platform for indie authors and small publishers. Over 13,000 authors from around the world have published more than 30,000 books at Smashwords.

ePublishing (as it is more accurately known) is the publishing of ebooks for mobile devices, like the Kindle.

Smashwords takes your original Microsoft Word source file, usually in .doc format, and converts it into multiple ebook formats such as .EPUB, PDF, .RTF, .PDB, .MOBI, LRF and TXT, as well as into online HTML and Javascript formats.

Preparation

I strongly recommend following Mark's advice, "It's [Style Guide] required reading if you want your ebook accepted into the Smashwords Premium Catalog for distribution to major online ebook retailers such as Apple, Barnes & Noble, Sony, Kobo, Diesel and Amazon." It should take you about an hour or so to familiarize yourself with the Style Guide.

And... "If you ever hear an author or reader complain that their Smashwords book looked like [insert your favorite expletive], it means the author didn't follow the Style Guide. Take the time to follow the guide. You've invested years – possibly even a lifetime – to write your masterpiece, so take 30 minutes or an

hour to study the Guide and learn how easy it is to create a good-looking multi-format ebook you and your readers will be proud of."

On the Smashwords site there are actually 2 examples of well-formatted Smashwords ebooks. Well worth having a look at these.

Forget everything you've read (or know) about book design, as your manuscript will need to be a very Word file that you upload to Smashwords.

Before you create your Smashwords account, have a flat cover image ready (this will be uploaded to Smashwords). The size should be 600 pixels wide by 900 pixels high.

1 Title and Synopsis

Title
The title of your book.

Short Description
The short description of your book appears in summary views and on your Smashwords book page, and is distributed to some retailers.

Instructions: Your short description will be used to market your book throughout the Smashwords site, and shared some with retailers. AVOID ALL CAPS, and do not enter email addresses, hyperlinks or promotions. Limited to 400 characters or fewer.

Long Description (optional)
The long descripton of your book appears on your Smashwords book page, and is distributed to most retailers.

NOTE: When you add the price for your ebook, you will see a chart that shows you the different portions everyone makes.



You have a variety of formats to choose from:

NOTE: If your book does not have graphics, tables or columns in, I would suggest choosing all the formats - it widens your market.

"Meatgrinder has other limitations. It doesn't support tables or columns. It doesn't take full advantage of some of the capabilities of formats such as EPUB and .MOBI. We're aware of the limitations, and you should be too." - Smashwords Style Guide

- **epub**
Your most important format. An open industry format, supported by the Sony Reader, Barnes & Noble Nook, most mobile apps [Stanza, Aldiko, Shortcovers], and many other reading systems.
- **Sony Reader (LRF)**
LRF is the format used on Sony Reader ebook devices.

- **Kindle (.mobi)**

Mobipocket is an eBook format supported on Windows PCs and many handheld devices. Important if you want your book easily importable into Amazon's Kindle reading device.

- **Palm Doc (PDB)**

PalmDoc is a format primarily used on Palm Pilot devices, but readers are available for PalmOS, Symbian OS, Windows Mobile Pocket PC/Smartphone, desktop Windows, and Macintosh.

- **PDF**

Portable Document Format, or PDF, is a file format readable by most devices, including handheld e-readers, PDAs, and computers. A good format if your work contains fancy formatting, charts or images.

- **RTF**

Rich Text Format, or RTF, is a cross-platform document format supported by many word processors and devices. Usually pretty good at preserving original formatting from Word documents.

- **Plain Text**

Plain text is the most widely supported file format, working on nearly all readers and devices. It lacks formatting, but will work anywhere. For best results with plain text, your source document should not contain fancy formatting or images.

When you are done filling in the form, browse to where your Word file (your ebook) is on your computer, and then click the **Publish** button.

Depending on the size of your file, it may take a few minutes to upload to Smashwords. You can actually log out, and carry on with something else while the file is uploading.

You will receive a confirmation mail that your ebook is uploaded.

When your ebook is uploaded, you can view the details in the Dashboard.


If your ebook has formatting errors, you will be able to find these through your Dashboard. You will need to fix the errors and then re-upload.

You can view all the details about your ebook, and you can download a free copy (in any format) to check.

Go to your Dashboard, and then click on your ebook's title (see below).

You can submit your ebook to Smashword's Premium Catalog. This means your book will be available to, "the Smashwords Premium Catalog for distribution to major online ebook retailers such as Apple, Barnes & Noble, Sony, Kobo, Diesel and Amazon."

You will need an ISBN to have your ebook included in the Premium Catalog, and the formatting must be 100% correct.

In Closing

Even though formatting an ebook for Smashwords takes a bit of time, and is different to formatting a PDF ebook, or hard copy ebook, you will have your ebook exposed to a bigger market.

Smashwords also have **The Smashwords Book Marketing Guide** - a really neat guide to help with the marketing of your ebook.

Give it a try.
